Business

- RI/FS update (Joe)
 - BERA/Sediment toxicity phase 3: Draft final facies mapping was released but we weren't offered the chance to comment.
 - HHRA: Robert Tan will talk with us during our formal EPA call in Sept. We need to remind him about Bob's question to include responses to supplementary material.
 - Soil amendment/technology (SATES): CCC provided comments in the phase 3/phase 4 (field testing and monitoring plans). Main comments for them to address were to provide contact information for the amendment suppliers, clarify acceptable levels for prescreening for contaminants, and to monitor for the full three years (CCT also asked for this). Kira has taken a new position as R10 Remedial Program Branch Chief, so Robert will be taking the lead on this project.
 - Aerial delineation: Nothing new
 - Sediment transport (keeping the thought alive)
 - Bossburg – nothing new and no real response to my question asked at the first webinar.
- Removal action: Ongoing, but Joe has not been following closely. Noted that Erika and Sherrie's places in town now have barricades around their yards as their remedial work continues. Joe reminded us that if there are still hot spots below 1 foot, a barrier is placed.
